



## Sgt. Major Andrew McCall

March 21, 1937 - January 19, 2019

Sgt. Major Andrew “Andy” Neal McCall, eldest son of the late Leander and SueNeal McCall, was born on March 21, 1937 in Lumberton, North Carolina. He departed this life on January 19, 2019 at Cape Fear Valley Medical Center, Fayetteville, North Carolina.

Andy, as he was affectionately known, joined the United States Army at the young age of 17. During his 24 years of prestigious service in the Army, Andy’s career ascended to many extraordinary experiences. Commencing as a Buck Private, he rose to the rank of Sergeant Major in a few short years. While serving in the military, Andy excelled in many leadership roles, to include Commandant of the Drill School, Chief ROTC Non-Commission Officer at Princeton University, Sergeant Major of the Organizational Effective Training School in Fort Ord, California.
