Annie Lee Thompson Davis Stroud was born on May 28, 1933, in Stedman, North Carolina. She was the first born of five children to the late Pauline Brown McLaurin. Later through the years, she was married to the late William Stroud where they made their residence in Cameron, North Carolina.

Annie lived a life of serving others.
