Epps High school class of 1964. She graduated from and was employed by Kittrell College 1969-1971 while she was enrolled. She later went on to study Health, Physical Education and Recreation at Fayetteville State University she graduated with the class of 1975, where she earned a Bachelors of Science degree. She later worked for Fayetteville State University after her tenure she would return later to the university where she earned her Master of Science in special education from Fayetteville State 1988-90.

Barbara met and married Willie Burn Leach April 1976. She is the proud mother of three sons James L.

Taft, Derrick Taft and Luther Leach one daughter Sharon Coggins-Velazquez. Barbara was employed at Fayetteville State University 1984-85 as Physical Education Teacher, she had a entrepreneurial spirit that prompted her and so she opened and operated her first daycare from 1972-1990 located on Blue Berry Place in 1983 she opened and operated three more centers. Her services we're 7 for children with disabilities as well as other children in the public school system.

She was also a Girl scouts trainer from 1985-1997, after which time she opened her first family care home. Named after herself "Barbie's Family Care home" in 1989 at 1720 Bridgette St., Fayetteville as a result of losing her

mother Mandy. Barbara decided to own and operate family care homes to provide services to adults with disabilities in need of care, she has taken residents into her home on several occasions with little or no funds for cost of care; and often planned and provide transportation and outings for her residents using her personal funds. Shortly after closing Barbie's Family Care home she later open and operated Leach's Family Care on Village Drive. While maintaining employment at Pitt County Memorial Hospital, and was a Mental Health Professional at Cumberland County Mental Health June 1989-1997. Barbara later established other small business entities over the next several years. During which time she was involved in her community and participated in various social and professional associations, she was a member of Order of Eastern Stars and Zeta Phi Beta. Barbara loved sports hence it's not a surprise that she would love football her favorite team was the Redskins before North Carolina got their own football team the Carolina Panthers. Her favorite athlete is Serena Williams. Her favorite tv show is Steve on Water. Her favorite gospel singer was Lee Williams her favorite song by him is Jesus will fix it.

Barbara lived and loved and laughed, She has never met a stranger anyone she met she immediately disarmed them with her smile and her kind words or gesture. She was vibrant and encouraging she was thoughtful and considerate she was kind and remained faithful to her ideals her belief in God never waivered she believed in His word and often encourage others with the scriptures. She believed God and his Grace as a result she spoke with confidence of his unchanging love.
