



## Mr. Bill Curtis "Dee" Bacote

Bill Curtis "Dee" Bacote (aka Uncle Goodbuddy) was born on March 27, 1946, in Parkton, NC as the thirteenth child and knee baby to the late Ernest Bacote Sr. and Mabel Bacote. Loyalty, hard work and brotherly love to a fault were instilled in the Bacote children and it would keep and bound them in love for a lifetime. Bill demonstrated this exceptional work ethic through his entire life, well into his 70s and would pass it along to each of his children through his bloodline.

Dee graduated from Oak Ridge High School, in Lumber Ridge, NC in 1964. Following high school, he attended A&T University in Greensboro, NC for two years when he left to work in textile manufacturing, first as a Technical Operator, but would quickly rise into the ranks of Supervisor, for his intelligence, and consummate professionalism. He would work in manufacturing in various Supervisory roles for many years to follow: at Trist, Burlington Industries, Temptation Hosiery, Sara Lee, WestPoint Pepperell, Rauch Industries and Fabtex always known as tough, hardworking, no-nonsense leader who also rewarded work ethic. Bill always moonlighted in a second job, umpiring for many years, buying aluminum for as many years, along with everything from pizza delivery and convenience store attendant. There was no work below him to make ends meet and provide for his loved

ones.

From his childhood through adulthood, Bill made friends easy, and had a passion for sports, specifically baseball and he would play recreationally with the Parkton Tigers for many years. He also loved himself some fresh hot catfish, a good soda and nab and working in the yard as relaxation. Bill was a loyal brother, uncle, partner and friend; a loving father to his sons and a doting and protective father to his daughter. Through the years he evolved into a much gentler version of the young man he once was-- never quick to anger, speak unkindly or present disagreeably toward anyone. Bill was a modest man, well liked, who lived a simple life and died quietly. We each will miss and remember him dearly in our own personal ways, whether it was him saving the day, completing a small task, imparting wisdom or just being a bright presence. If he loved or cared for you--there was some impression or impact of note.

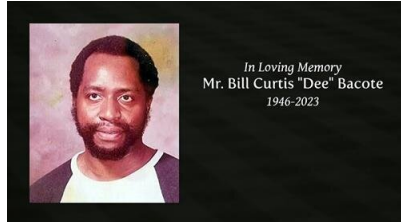
