Christine Greer Lockhart, better known by those who loved her as “Fuzzy”, was born on July 2, 1957, in Shreveport, Louisiana. She was the third of seven children born to Wiley Lee, Sr. and Magnolia Greer. At the age of 6, her family relocated to Houston, Texas where she lived the early years of her life and received her education in the Houston Independent School District. Although she did not complete her studies at Jefferson Davis High School, she obtained her GED and attended both Texas Southern University and Houston Community College.

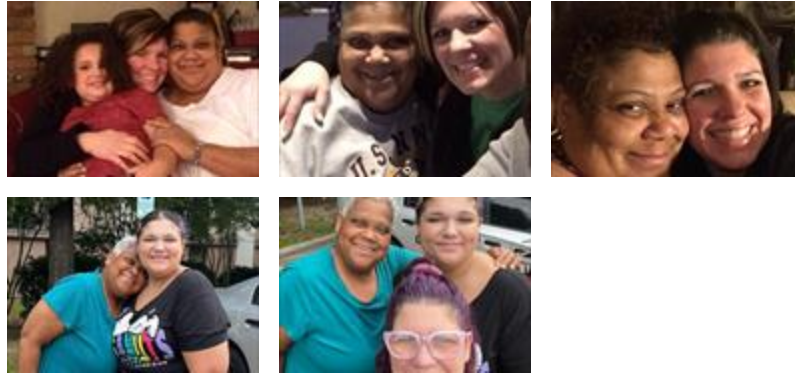

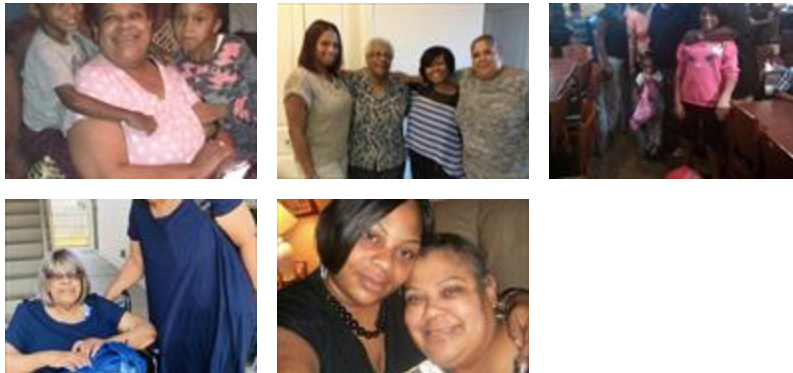
