He grew up as the child of a military parent, traveling around the world until his family decided to plant roots in Sanford, North Carolina. As early as grade school, he understood the importance of education, and he set goals to one day graduate from college and live his adult life helping others.

D'Angelo graduated from Western Harnett High School and matriculated on to North Carolina Central University, where he graduated in 2008 with a Bachelor's degree in both Hospitality and Tourism Administration. D'Angelo began his military career as an enlisted soldier in the North Carolina National Guard and was commissioned through the Warrant Officer Candidate School at Fort Rucker, Alabama, in 2015. As a Warrant Officer, he attended several military schools, including the Mobility Officer Basic Course, the Mobility Officer Advanced Course, the Mobilization Deployment Planning Course, and the TC-AIMS II Functional Course. His military assignments showed progression at every detachment, company, brigade, and division level, advancing

him to his current rank of Chief Warrant Officer Three.

His military decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal, the Army Commendation Medal, the Army Achievement Medal, the Army Good Conduct Medal, the Army Reserve Component Achievement Medal, the National Defense Service Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Afghanistan Campaign Medal, the Iraq Campaign Medal, the Army Service Ribbon, the Overseas Service Ribbon, the Armed Forces Reserve Medal, and the State Active Duty Ribbon, all of which reflect outstanding accomplishment within his assignments in the Continental United States and abroad. D'Angelo was affiliated with several civilian and military organizations. He was an Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation New Dawn Veteran.

D'Angelo was a hard-working family man who loved helping others. He especially loved sports and was a true Dallas Cowboys fan. All who knew him can still hear him say, "How 'bout DEM BOYS!" He was outgoing, family-oriented, kind, and full of life. His joyful and generous spirit was infectious to all who knew him.
