



Mr. Dedrick Terrell Robinson

September 16, 1980 - February 7, 2023

Mr. Dedrick Terrell Robinson, son of William and Vera Scott Robinson, was born September 16, 1980 in Osceola, Arkansas. He departed this life peacefully on February 7, 2023 at Durham Veterans Administration Medical Center with his father by his side.

While growing up in Arkansas, Dedrick attended church and sang alongside his father in the church choir. Dedrick attended Osceola High School in Osceola, Arkansas and graduated in 1998. He was an active player on the school's Varsity Basketball Team. Dedrick gave football a try, but after receiving a "wrong hit", he decided football wasn't the sport for him. He attended Campbell University and graduated with a B.S. Degree in Criminal Justice in 2013.

In March 2000, Dedrick joined the United States Air Force and completed his military training at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas. Dedrick completed six years of active duty service at Pope Air Force Base. In 2007, Dedrick joined the United States Air Force Reserves (Pope Air Force Base) and upon its closing, he transferred to Seymour Johnson Air Force Base. Dedrick retired in January

2023.

Dedrick completed two tours in Iraq during his military career. He received several

awards, medals, and recognition for his service. While in the military, Dedrick made countless friends; many became a part of his family life.

While serving in the United States Air Force Reserves, Dedrick worked for ten years at FedEx Express as a courier in Fayetteville, North Carolina. Due to his unexpected illness, he was not able to retire from FedEx Express as he desired.

Dedrick's personality enabled him to gain lifelong friends while being employed

with FedEx Express, and he adopted many of them as family.

Dedrick and Khanna were married June 24, 2004 in Fayetteville, North Carolina

and made their home in Spring Lake, North Carolina. Khanna's hometown is Raeford, North Carolina. Dedrick affectionately showed his love for his wife and

children. He was a supportive husband and father, enjoyed engaging in his family's

extra curricular activities, and served as a volunteer coach for the Cumberland County Community Recreational Centers.

Dedrick's pride and joy was his family which he put first, and he worked tirelessly

proving it. Even throughout his illness, Dedrick's "gentle giant" demeanor never

waivered. Dedrick lived his life as a living testimony for God; he often said, "God

had a plan for my life."
