DeMott Roger McKelley departed this life on Sunday, December 27, 2020, shortly after 6 AM. He was the son of Darlene Haynes-McKelley and the late Oscar Homer C. (Tee) McKelley. He was born August 13, 1976, in Youngstown, Ohio.

DeMott spent his formative school years in the Youngstown public school system and graduated from Chaney High School in 1994. He was a member of Lincoln Avenue Christian Church. He played basketball for Holy Trinity Junior High School. On November 20, 1996, DeMott entered the Army and served his first enlistment in Manheim, Germany, as part of the 44th Signal Battalion as a cook. He was honorably discharged on November 19, 1999. He continued to serve as a member of the Army Reserve in Lawton, Oklahoma, before reentering the Army on January 04, 2002, where he continued to serve as a cook. DeMott completed two tours in Iraq before being honorably discharged on March 27, 2008. After leaving the Army, he worked for the Cape Fear Valley Health System as a cook. He received his Barbering Certificate from Miller-Motte College in 2016 and later worked as a cook for Carolina Inn at Village Green.

DeMott was united in holy matrimony to Ashantee McKelley on February 14, 2000, in Lawton, Oklahoma. He was a loving father to his two children Bre'Ana and De'Antae McKelley. He will truly be missed.
