Deaconess Dixie Arnetta Morgan Alfred was born October 14, 1932 in Raleigh, NC., to the late Neal and Nannie Collins Morgan. She entered into eternal rest on July 27, 2019. She was preceded in death by four brothers and two sisters.

Dixie was educated in the public schools of Raleigh, NC., graduating from Washington High School and Payne Business College Raleigh, NC. Following graduation from Payne Business College she was employed at Mechanics and Farmers Bank, Raleigh, NC. She later retired from Carolina Power and Light Co.
