Edward Dean Fleming, 46, of Lillington died recently at his home. He was born May 17, 1966, in Brooklyn, N.Y., and relocated to Lillington in 1976, where he attended Shawtown Elementary School, Lillington Middle School and Harnett Central High School. He entered the U.S. Navy at age 17 and received an honorable discharge in 1987. Mr. Fleming graduated from basic law enforcement training in 1988 and worked in Coats, Dunn and Lillington as a police officer until retirement. He was preceded in death by his wife, Lori Fleming.
