other family and friends.

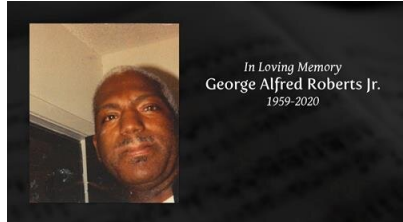

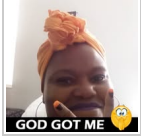
