Gillespie Joseph Scott, 83, a resident of Fayetteville N.C. passed away on Saturday July 2, 2022. He was a proud Vietnam War veteran serving in the United States Army 82nd Airborne Infantry Division. He received several awards one of which was the Bronze Star for meritorious achievement in ground operations against hostile forces in the Republic of Vietnam during the period of July 1965 - June 1966. After retiring from the military on March 31, 1979, Mr. Scott worked for NVT Technologies Incorporation, Research Triangle Park, Durham, NC as an Operations and Maintenance Engineer over 20 years where he received several awards and accolades during his tenure.
