At approximately 12:00am, September 5, 2024, at Duke University Hospital, Durham, NC, Harold Junior Bell was called home. The son of Geneva B. Williams and to the late Jackie H. Williams, Sr., Harold was born on June 4, 1956, in Clinton, NC.

Harold was a 1974 graduate of Clinton High School and was a dedicated player of the Dark Horse Football team. Harold wore the number 32 and played the position as running back/half back, often referred to himself as Dr. J or JJ. Harold married his high school sweetheart Renee Anthony in 1977. During this union, they had two beautiful kids, Craig and Tanisha.

Harold served in the U.S. Army for 21 years and retired in 1996. After serving, Harold worked for the Department of Public Safety and retired in July 2017.
