



## Mr. James Rogers

June 1, 1950 - November 24, 2023

On June 1, 1950, in Lumberton, North Carolina, a son named James Rudolph Rogers was born to James Rudolph Rogers, Sr. and Lydia Rogers. James was raised by his mother along with his five brothers: John Miles, Craven Miles, Alford Lee Rogers, Rhynie Earl Rogers, and Randy King his two sister:: Lydia Miles and Diane King. James experienced a joyful childhood with his mother and siblings. He matured at an early age while assuming a role of responsibility for watching his younger siblings while his mother worked. He also learned to cook at an early age and later fine-tuned those skills by studying culinary arts.

Angela and James shared many beautiful moments when she lived with him as a teenager in Houston. He later developed a loving and close bond with her as an adult.

James married Bernadette Banks in 1982, and in 1983 they were blessed with one son, Akil Jamar. James and Bernadette raised Akil in three states during his childhood, which included: North Carolina, New York and Texas. Akil spent

several years in Galveston, Texas while living in the home of his maternal grandparents, Joseph and Doris Banks, along with his parents, James lived in Galveston for over twenty years.

James was preceded in death by his mother, Lydia Vivian, father, James Rudolph, brother, John, Craven, Alford and Rhynie. Nephews, Hawkins Omoregbe (Boo), and Marcus Joseph Netherly.

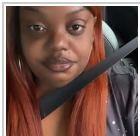
