THE LIFE BIOGRAPHY OF JAMES ALLEN GREENE SKINNER was born in Brooklyn, New York on April 6, 1945, to the late Geneva and David Greene St. He was the youngest of four children. 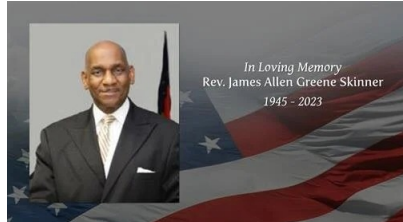
