Mr. James A. Williams departed this life on February 7, 2021 at his home. He was 89 years old. James was born in Robeson County on April 27, 1931, to the late Alton and Pearlene Williams. He was educated in the Robeson County Schools System. He graduated from Oak Ridge High School in Lumber Bridge, N.C. James furthered his education at Fayetteville Technical Community College, receiving a certification in Brick Mason.

He was a lifelong member of Mt. Hebrew A.M.E. Zion Church in Parkton, N.C. James served his country by enlisting in the United States Army. After serving his country he returned home and became employed as a Civil Service Worker. He worked at the Main Post Commissary in Fort Bragg, N.C.
