John Frederick Dzienny, Retired Lieutenant Colonel of the U.S. Army, died in his home Sept. 22, 2023, of natural causes in Fayetteville, North Carolina. He was born July 22, 1968 in Toledo, Ohio to Frederick and Mary Jane Dzienny (deceased).
