



## SFC Latashia Lynne Hairston

July 9, 1976 - May 10, 2025

SFC Latashia Lynne Hairston was born on July 9, 1976, in Roanoke, Virginia, the firstborn of three children to Myra Goodrich Broadnax and her stepfather, Thomas Broadnax. She received her early education in the Roanoke City Schools before graduating from Morehead High School in Eden, North Carolina.

Latashia was a devoted member of Rising Star Memorial Baptist Church in Eden, NC, where she faithfully served as the leader of the children's ministry, taught Sunday School, and sang in the choir.

After high school, Latashia enlisted in the United States Army, where she served with distinction as a Counterintelligence Special Agent. A decorated Army veteran, she received numerous honors including the Joint Service Medal, Army Achievement Medal, Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, and the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal. Her dedication and professionalism were further recognized with the NCO Professional Development Ribbon, Army Service Ribbon, and Overseas Service Ribbon. She was honorably discharged in 2004.

Following her military career, Latashia relocated to Fayetteville, North Carolina, in 2017. There, she joined Spring Lake Memorial Baptist Church, serving faithfully in the media and children's ministries. Her commitment to

ministry continued as she became an integral part of Bethel AME Zion Church, where she contributed her talents to the media, children, and dance ministries.

In 2023, “Tasha,” as she was affectionately known, became a devoted member of Cornerstone Christian Empowerment Center under the leadership of Bishop Bennie L. Bryant Jr. Wherever there was a need, Tasha was there supporting her church family through media production, administrative assistance, and a heart ready to serve.

Tasha also found great joy in singing with the award-winning Jared L. Payton and the Voices, now known as The Legacy Chorale. Her love for worship through music became a central part of her life. She held leadership positions as Assistant to the Director and Treasurer and shared this passion with her children and family—creating moments of unity and joy that will live on.

Latashia leaves to cherish her memory her beloved children: Tahir Amari Hairston, Joshua Maurice Witherspoon, and Yasirah AASAMA Brown; her loving parents Thomas and Myra Broadnax; her father Joe Burwell Sr., and her partner Mr. Preston Brown. She is also survived by her brothers: Rodney Goodrich Jr. Joe Burwell Jr. and Lamont Burwell; and her sisters: Tamisha Broadnax, Crystal L. Burwell, and Lakeshia Burwell. She was preceded in death by her sister Sharita D. Hairston. A special place in her heart was held for her uncle “Jay” Hairston, along with numerous aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and dear friends who will forever treasure her light, laughter, and love.
