

## Mr. Lendo Regan

July 11, 1941 - December 4, 2024

On the afternoon of December 4, 2024, Lendo Regan was called to rest eternally by our Savior Jesus Christ and to never feel pain or sorrow again.

Lendo was the son of the late Velma Regan and grandson of the late Bristol and Emma Bell Regan. He was an only child born July 11, 1941, in Tar Heel, North Carolina.

To family, he was a loving surrogate uncle and cousin. To others, he was a cherished co-worker and trustworthy friend.

Lendo attended Bladen Central High School in Elizabethtown, North Carolina and graduated in 1960.

Upon graduation, he attended Agricultural and Technical College of North Carolina (currently NCA&T) where he received his Bachelor of Science in Business Administration in 1964. In 1960, he participated in the Greensboro Sit-ins during the Civil Rights Movement. Post graduation he was drafted by the United States Army where he served two years in combat during the Vietnam War.

Post military service, Lendo moved to New York, New York and carved out a career and life of innovation

with JP Morgan Chase for 30+ years. He survived 9/11 during his career at JP Morgan Chase and retired leaving a legacy of being a trailblazer in finance, accounting and technology.

During retirement, Lendo's passion continued to be his love for New York City, and photography that took him around the world. He shared his hobby of photography with his family and friends. He loved to discuss politics and current events, eat "duck", was an AWESOME storyteller and avid user of Apple devices!

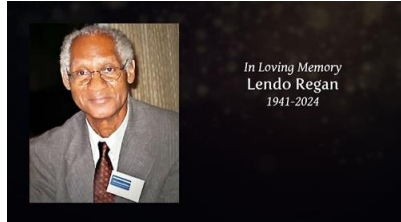
