Lula Pearl Cable was born September 30, 1939, to the late Luvenia Parks Williams in Hope Hull, Alabama. She peacefully departed this life surrounded by loved ones on Sunday, March 10, 2024, at Cape Fear Valley Medical Center and entered into the "shelter of the Most High" (Psalm 91)

Pearls was educated in the public schools of Montgomery, Alabama where she graduated from George Washington carver High School. She joined Mount Olive Missionary Baptist Church in the 1980's under the leadership of Pastor Berry B. Irby and served faithfully in numerous capacities over the years: Mission Group #3 (Nursing Home), New Members Program Leader, Mission Group #4 (World Missions), Mission Group 312 (Military Support), Couples Ministry and the Carl E. Brinkley, Jr. Mass Choir.

She was employed with the Army Air Force Exchange Service (AAFES) for 10 years and afterwards served 21 years as a prime-Time Site Director for the Cumberland County School System.
