Marshall Glenn Hollingsworth, Sr., born July 12, 1957, to the late Neal Archie Hollingsworth, Sr. and Gladys Treadwell Hollingsworth in Fayetteville, North Carolina, was called to eternal rest on Sunday, October 20, 2024, at his home in High Point, North Carolina.

He matriculated from E.E. Smith High School in Fayetteville, North Carolina in June of 1975 with academic honors as well as scholarship accommodations for the United States Military Academy at West Point in New York. Glenn continued to pursue his educational goals by receiving a Baccalaureate Degree from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill in August 1980. He dedicated over fifteen years to DAKS, Incorporated in Fayetteville, North Carolina, before relocating his family to High Point, North Carolina where he retired from KAO Specialties Americas in January 2024.

Glenn confessed Christ and was baptized at St. Luke AME Zion Church. He had a passion for Corvettes and Harley Davidson motorcycles, eagerly attending the Harley Davidson Bike Rally in Daytona Beach, Florida and Bike Week in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina each year.

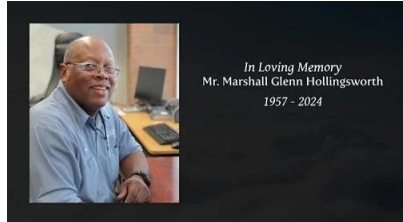
