Michael was born on January 23, 1960, in Fayetteville, North Carolina, the youngest child of Arthur Lee Lane and Celesta Belle Lane.

The family were members of First Baptist Church of Fayetteville, NC.

He graduated from E. E. Smith High School in 1978. He followed his father's footsteps and pledged Omega Psi Phi in 1980, and graduated from Howard University in Washington DC, with a major in Finance in 1983. He received his Juris Doctorate from North Carolina Central University in Durham North Carolina in 1986. He was licensed to practice law in the state of Pennsylvania.

He worked as a magistrate at the Cumberland County Courthouse for 16 years. He later did legal research for law firms in Charlotte, and later in Morrisville, North Carolina.

He was also a licensed minister, Minister of Prayer, and assisted Pastor Davenport at the Family Fellowship Worship Center in Fayetteville, NC traveling to the Bahamas for missionary outreach.

He was an avid weightlifter working at Pro Mark Fitness and Golds Gym for years.

He was first married to Barbara Coley in 1986 and has one child to that union, Rachel Lane, 3 grandchildren, and one great-grand child. His second marriage was to Roberta Ann Loudermilk of Lexington NC.

He is preceded in death by his mother, Celesta Lane (2/7/2021), and his father, Arthur Lane in (4/29/2006).
