



Retired MSG Glenn Ray Murray

September 23, 1950 - July 30, 2025

Glenn Ray Murray, son of the late Willie Murray and Frankie Richmond-Reese, was born September 23, 1950, in Bolton, Mississippi. He departed this life on July 30, 2025 after a lengthy illness.

He was a member of Mt. Elizabeth Missionary Baptist Church and later became a member of Lewis Chapel Missionary Baptist Church after moving to Fayetteville, NC. He received his early education at Utica Junior College in Utica, MS. He then joined the United States Army and retired after more than 24 years of service. He then graduated from Washington State Criminal Justice Academy, and became a Corrections Officer, and retired from King County Adult and Juvenile Detention with 25 years of service.

He was a faithful member of the Masonic Order, earning the titles of: Past Worshipful Master of Union Lodge #63, Past Patron of Mt. Rainier #01, Past Grand Patron of the Order of the Eastern Star, Washington & its Jurisdictions, Past Potentate of Beni Hassan # 64, and Sublime Prince of Prince Hall Consistory #67 and nominated for the last and final 33rd degree.

He enjoyed home cooked meals, grilling on the patio, collecting and talking about new weapons with his military buddies. He was an avid Baltimore Ravens football fan and enjoyed hanging with the gang on football Sundays. (none of us had the same team - Patriots, Commanders, Chiefs, Browns and

Cowboys). There was always lots of yelling going on!

Glenn was preceded in death by his father, Willie Murray, his mother, Frankie Richmond-Reese, and his brother, James Reese.

He leaves to mourn his wife, Stephanie Murray; three stepdaughters, Raquel Langer, Deidra Strickland (Lynn), YeVette Redd (Sherman); two sisters, Precious Robinson, and Frances Williams (BJ), and a host of grandchildren great grandchildren, nieces and nephews, and friends.
