Mrs. Patricia Ann Lewis, affectionately known as "Kriquet Lew," was a beacon of love, wisdom, and grace. Born on February 6, 1947, in Fayetteville, NC, she was the beloved daughter of the late Clarence McKinnon Sr and Mary McCoy McKinnon. On January 25, 2025 Patricia peacefully transitioned from this life, leaving behind a rich legacy of faith, strength, and unwavering devotion to her family and community.

Patricia was preceded in death by her parents and 5 cherished brothers: Steven, Darryl, Jim, Ronald, and Clarence Jr. Though they are no longer with us, their memories remained vibrant as she shared countless childhood stories about her siblings.
