“ Mrs. Retha and I met in the Summer of 1989 when I came to Mount Olive, since that time we have shared in an awesome relationship. My memories of Mrs. Retha are both bitter and sweet. Many days while working at the church in the capacity of custodian or sexton as she would often remind me. I would often take my lunch breaks at her home under the big tree talking with her as she cared for her husband, the late Rev. A.C. Jones. I remember walking up to Bragg Blvd checking her mailbox on most days, something I looked forward to. Mrs. Retha offered her garage to the church to store lawn mowers and various equipment. I recall the day, as though it was weeks ago when she called the church and asked me and Bobo to rush over to help get Rev. Jones back in bed, she had left him for a moment to go up the street to the store and he attempted to get out and fell, it really shook her. I remember the home-going service for Rev. Jones, her son Martel gave the eulogy, the title of his eulogy has stayed with me all these years "My Daddy, The Anvil." Few people speak volumes in their silence and Mrs. retha was certainly one of those few, she didn't say much but when she did speak it was well worth listening to. The past few months have seen several of our saints called to heaven: Malcolm McQuaige, Glenda Woodard, Elizabeth Taylor, Deac. Joe West and now Mrs. Retha, although she is no longer with us in the flesh her spirit will continue to resonate throughout and I know the angels are rejoicing as her spirit grace heaven's way.
