overseas for 4 years, two of which were in Vietnam. In the military he was trained and certified as a

master mechanic. He received honorable discharge in June of 1973 after

serving a total of 7 years. After attending technical school in Virginia, he became a certified Upholster. Roger used his acquired skills and worked for himself for the remainder of his healthy life. After serving his country Roger resided in New Jersey and started Jones Upholstery with his wife Rebeca Jones and their four children. However, fate was cruel and the marriage did not survive. Attempting to reestablish himself, Roger moved to Philadelphia where he established Jones Auto Repair and met his loving partner Debbie Campbell, which produced one child. Years later he found himself in Washington, D.C. where he met and later married the late Elisa Brewington Jones, who had four children. Together they shared Jones upholstery until her health declined. He was preceded in death by his baby girl, Detina Jones, His sister: Marie Jones, his brothers: Colonel Lee, Willie Jones, George Jones, Carlton Bouldin and Perry Jones.
