



Mr Thaddeus W. McIver

April 29, 1936 - June 8, 2020

Thaddeus W. McIver of Spring Lake, North Carolina passed away the morning of Monday, June 8, 2020, after a short battle with COVID-19. Thaddeus, a beloved great-grandfather, grandfather, father, uncle, cousin and friend, was 84.

Thaddeus was born in Spring Lake on April 29, 1936, to father John Daniel McIver and mother Pauline King McIver. The youngest of seven brothers and two sisters, he enlisted in the army during the Korean War and served his country on the frontline in Korea. Thaddeus was a small business owner in the metal finishing industry in New Jersey for many years before retiring in his beloved hometown of Spring Lake, North Carolina.

His first passion was his children, and he would often make elaborate meals for his family. Thaddeus was known by family and friends for his hard work ethic and generosity. His home was always open to friends and family in need. Thaddeus was an avid storyteller often keeping his family amused by his childhood pursuits. He possessed a keen intellect, and he was never short of an opinion whether you wanted one or not.

Thaddeus was preceded in death by his life-long partner Della Holder, his parents and by his seven brothers and two sisters Lewis Arthur McIver, Retha Mae McIver Jones, John Harrison McIver, Ralph Mitchell McIver, James Nicholson McIver, Creo Melvin McIver, Christine Vendelle McIver-Holloway, Walter Rogers McIver and Richard Donnell McIver. He is survived by his children Colesia McIver, Felice McIver, Ivan Smith, Leonard Smith, LaVonne McIver James, Delenia McIver, Daniel McIver and Thaddeus McIver Jr.; grandchildren Jenera, Sheldon, Yolanda, Kiani, Jasmine, Jayla, Matt Jr., Dan Jr., Quentel, Billy, Lynaia, Kailynn, Salma, Carter, Landon, Dean, Isaiah, Anaiah and Carolina; great-grandchildren Jaleel, Jayden, Chris, Kayla, Zion, Jayden and A'rion and a host of nieces, nephews, cousins and many friends.

A private visitation for Thaddeus is planned for Wednesday, June 17th, from 10 am to 12 pm. The visitation will be at Colvin Funeral Home at 2010 Murchison Road, Fayetteville, North Carolina. The burial will follow immediately at 1 pm at Hillside Cemetery, Spring

Lake, North Carolina. Those who are able to attend, and comfortable to do so given present circumstances and restrictions, are welcome.

Given the valid concerns and restrictions on congregating and traveling during the COVID-19 pandemic, and the impact this has on having a traditional funeral and service at this time, we understand that many will not be present on June 17th. Family and friends wishing to honor Thaddeus' life will have the opportunity to do at a Homecoming Celebration to Honor the Life of Thaddeus W. McIver that will be held in Spring Lake once the current crisis is over and people can get together without restrictions.
