She was a faithful member of New Genesis Fresh Start Ministries where she served on the Kitchen Ministry and waited on anyone who desired her assistance. Thelma was the Vice President of the Usher Board and greeted everyone with her beautiful, full of joy smile. When you left her presence, she would always say “I love you”.
