Thomas Woolridge was born in Augusta Ga, on December 7th in 1936 to the late James L. Woolridge and Lois C. Patton. He was raised in New York where he began his military career. He departed this life on February 5, 2024.

Thomas later transferred to Fort Bragg where he continued to serve throughout his military career of 24 years of service.
