On October 8, 2023, Venus passed away. She left this world too soon, and we will always miss and remember her.

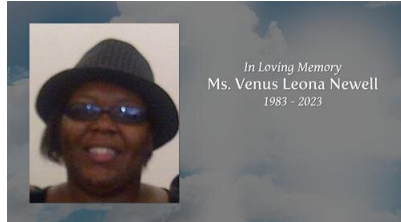
Her father, Albert Daniel Newell and grandfather, Kenneth B. Stewart preceded her in death.
