



Mr. Vincent James Earl Braxton

March 25, 1972 - May 10, 2025

In the infinite wisdom of the Lord, Vincent James Earl Braxton departed this life on Saturday, May 10, 2025, at the age of 53. He was born on March 25, 1972, in Fayetteville, North Carolina. Vincent was the only child of Major James Earl Braxton, US Army (Ret) and Mildred McIntyre Braxton. Vincent was also the youngest grandchild of the late Walter and Rebecca Hooks McIntyre and the late Garfield and Susan Braxton.

Vincent received his early Christian instruction and training at First Baptist Church, 302 Moore Street in Fayetteville, North Carolina under the pastoral leadership of Reverend Dr. Cureton L. Johnson and the late Reverend Dr. C. R. Edwards. Vincent joined First Baptist Church on January 1, 1984, and he was baptized on February 12, 1984. He participated in training and youth activities such as Sunday School and the Boy Scouts.

Vincent received his education in Cumberland County Schools, graduating from Terry Sanford High School in 1990. Fulfilling his desire for higher education, Vincent attended Livingstone College in Salisbury, North Carolina. He completed the requirements for graduation in December 1997, and he was conferred a Bachelor of Arts degree in Sociology at Livingstone College at the annual commencement ceremony on May 9, 1998.

After graduation, Vincent resided in Portsmouth, Virginia where he was

employed by a security company. He later returned to Fayetteville to live and work. He faithfully fulfilled his civic responsibility by voting consistently in local, state, and national elections. He found interest in current affairs as he would attend family, church and local gatherings, city festivals and community events.

Vincent is preceded in death by his parents, Major James Earl Braxton, US Army (Ret) and Mildred McIntyre Braxton, who loved him dearly. Lovingly cherishing his memory are a host of cousins, including Ernest G. Broom of High Point, North Carolina; Joseph C. Hill of Navarre, Florida; Desdy H.
