



## Mr. Walter Barron Green

September 3, 1953 - September 9, 2024

Walter Barron Green was born in Jesup, Georgia on September 3, 1953, to the late Reverend Charlie Henry Green and Cuba Dunlap Green. He is predeceased by his sister, Gloria Green Allen. He departed this life on September 9, 2024, in Fayetteville, NC.

Barron accepted Jesus Christ at a young age and was baptized when he joined Bennett Union Missionary Baptist Church in Jesup, Georgia. He later joined Morning Glory Missionary Baptist, Jesup, Georgia, where his father was pastor. He and Wondalyn Quinn were married on June 29, 1980. He was a former member of Mt. Olive Missionary Baptist Church, where he joined in 1996, and was baptized by Dr. Carl E. Brinkley, Jr. As a member of the Drama Ministry, he used his gift as a saxophone player and as narrator for a play. As a stagehand, he assisted The Jesus Troupe with recent anniversary celebrations.

Barron received his formal education in Jesup, Georgia having graduated from Wayne County High School in 1971. He attended Savannah State University, Savannah, Georgia, where he studied mechanical engineering. He was a certified boiler maker and was previously employed at Hercules Steel, Fayetteville, NC. He was a gifted saxophonist, pianist and singer, but those who knew him best would say that his greatest God-given gift was being an automotive mechanic. No matter the make or model, he could listen to a

vehicle and determine the problem. His skills weren't limited to vehicles. He could assemble and repair many different things.
