William Z. McNeill Sr. was born on February 14, 1953, to John McNeill Sr. and Eva McNeill. He began his Christian experience while singing in the youth choir and learned how to persevere through playing sports. William (or Coach) graduated from E.E. Smith High School in 1971 and joined the military in (date of entry into the military). While serving his country, William got married and fathered two sons, Demetrius and William Jr. It was in the military that William learned the value of mentoring and the importance of sports in the development of a person.

His passion was coaching and mentoring young people.

Coach McNeill loved to see young athletes soar to the next level in their lives. He was the first black coach at the Fayetteville Academy. He coached at Fayetteville State University, and later went on to Winston Salem State University where he won two CIAA Championships 99-00. He went back to Fayetteville State University and volunteered with Coach Sam Hanger and Coach Waldo Houser. Upon leaving there he went on to coach in the Semi-Pro League the Fayetteville Flights, and later with the Winston Salem Mavericks with Coach Willie Patcher.

He was the Chairman of Fayetteville Cumberland Parks and Recreation. He wore many other hats. He was a mentor and recruiter for many, his love for the youth was phenomenal. There was nothing he wouldn't do for the youth to make sure that they had what they needed to be successful in life.

Coach McNeill later went on to join Sunnyside Presbyterian Church. He was installed as an Elder at Sunnyside Presbyterian in January 2017. The love he had for his church family was unconditional. Elder McNeill expanded the Sunnyside Food Pantry to assist deserving families. He served on many Presbyterians boards to ensure that the gospel would be shared with all

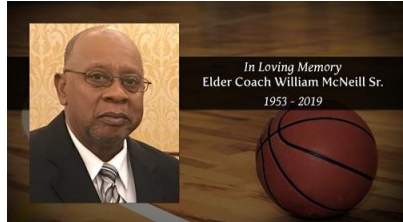
