Zack William Landis, affectionately known to family as “ZW”, heard the call of the Lord beckoning him to come home to receive his reward on April 29, 2024. Zack was born on October 11, 1928, in Creedmoor, North Carolina to the Late Samuel Landis and Eva Bailey Landis Fields. He was preceded in death by his wife, Bessie McDonald Landis, his parents, one sister, Helen Davis, one brother, Clarence Fields, Jr., and daughter, Evelyn Landis.

Zack graduated from E.E. Smith High School in Fayetteville, North Carolina. Upon graduation, he enlisted in the military and served in the United States Army and United States Navy during the Korean War. He later earned a Bachelor of Arts in Sociology from National University. Zack was employed with the Veterans Affairs Fayetteville Coastal Medical Center in Fayetteville, North Carolina, and retired after 29 years of service in the Psychiatry Unit.

Zack was a faithful member of the First Missionary Baptist Church in Parkton, North Carolina. He enjoyed serving in many capacities: Deacon Board, Financial Secretary, Sunday School Teacher, Church Clerk, and Treasurer of the Union Baptist Association. He was also a member of Eureka Masonic Lodge No. 3, Fayetteville, North Carolina.
